At the heart of the Lincoln Park Coast Cultural District lies the remaining facade of the South Park Presbyterian Church along with a vacant lot where the church once stood. A symbol to a storied past, LPCCD envisions this site as a unique opportunity for the fusion of several programmatic elements that will transform this vacant lot to a 'townsquare' for this developing neighborhood that will include a hydroponic community farm, a neighborhood square, outdoor Classrooms, an 'arts garden and a performance venue.

Arterial is the project Landscape Architect for this dynamic space in collaboration with a project Architect and and restoration specialist for the facade. Arterial facilitated a full-day stakeholder design charrette with all neighborhood leaders, residents and artists. Furthering LPCCD's goal as a sustainable neighborhood, Arterial designed a unique stormwater collection and reuse system that captured roofwater from adjacent buildings. As with any urban space, careful care was taken to ensure proper safety and security while creating a beautiful and inviting space for the community.
